The stock is a mixture of kit and modified ready to run. Presently all the locomotives are converted RTR examples, but hopefully genuine 2mm scale kits will be available to run soon. At the time of writing (2024) Wansbeck Road has been under construction for 35 years, and still not complete.....! It moved from it's original home in the UK (where it was exhibited at 93 exhibitions) to the care of the South East Queensland Area Group of the 2mm Association in 2023. Anyone interested in 2mm Fine Scale modelling or the activities of the 2mm Scale Association is invited to speak to the operators for more information. Wansbeck Road featured in Model Railway Journal No 164 January 2006 and British Railway Modelling in November 2006, but has changed slightly since these articles appeared. An update article appeared in Railway Modeller in the March 2013 issue.</p>

Its Passenger Services ranged from smartly timed expresses to intense and complex local workings around Liverpool and Manchester. Through a team of energetic and competent managers the railway was at the forefront engineering development. It was an early user of Belpaire firebox and the first to introduce superheated steam. Electrification of local services started in 1904 and it operated the largest railway owned shipping fleet in the country. The locomotive in their smart black paint with red and white lining and oval brass number plates hauled trains of lake and tan liveried carriages and long freight trains over the difficult Pennine terrain.
